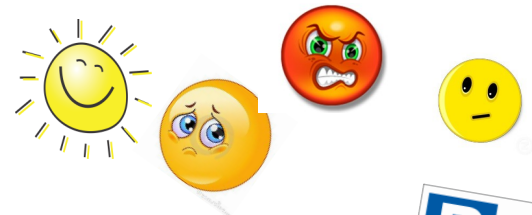

Please remember that Preschool is open from **9.15am** only, unless by prior arrangement with Amanda. We try to be as flexible and accommodating as possible and will try to help with earlier drop offs, but these **HAVE** to be arranged prior to the day to ensure we can accommodate this for safeguarding reasons.

Collection times are **12.15pm, 1pm** or **2.45pm** depending on your child's session. Pick ups need to be prompt, most importantly to take into account that the building itself is not privately owned & other clubs use the building immediately after Preschool closes. If a child is late being collected, this can pose a potential safeguarding issue.

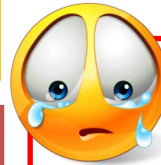
Daily Outside Set Up
